The **T**ransfer **A**cademy for **T**omorrow's **E**ngineers (**TATE**) program was designed for undergraduate students, majoring in Engineering, interested in transferring to UTSA. **TATE** in partnering with the **U**nder**G**raduate **R**esearch, **E**ducation **A**nd **T**raining (**U-GREAT**) program sponsored by U.S. Department of Agriculture provides you with a unique summer experiential learning opportunity.

Accepted students will participate in an intense summer program which will: (1) focus on research & technical writing skills (2) allow you to learn about green energy and sustainability, (3) furnish you with skills to write a final research paper and final presentation. Students will also receive networking opportunities and a \$1,000 dollar scholarship after successful completion of the summer camp.

Students will also have an opportunity to compete for a 4-week paid hand-on research internship sponsored by **U-GREAT/USDA** at a UTSA Lab on campus.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be admissible & enroll full-time at UTSA Fall 2018
- Must major in Engineering
- Must have 2.9 cumulative GPA
- Must have successfully completed Physics I (2425)
- Mandatory attendance & completion of summer program
